Over 5,000 kilos of ivory tusks were seized at airports in 2016 - this is equivalent to two dead elephants a day (Environmental Investigation Agency).



Rhino

Over 320 kilos of rhino horn were seized at airports in 2017 – this is at least 105 dead rhinos (Poaching Facts).

There are only 3,200 wild tigers left in the world (United for Wildlife).
